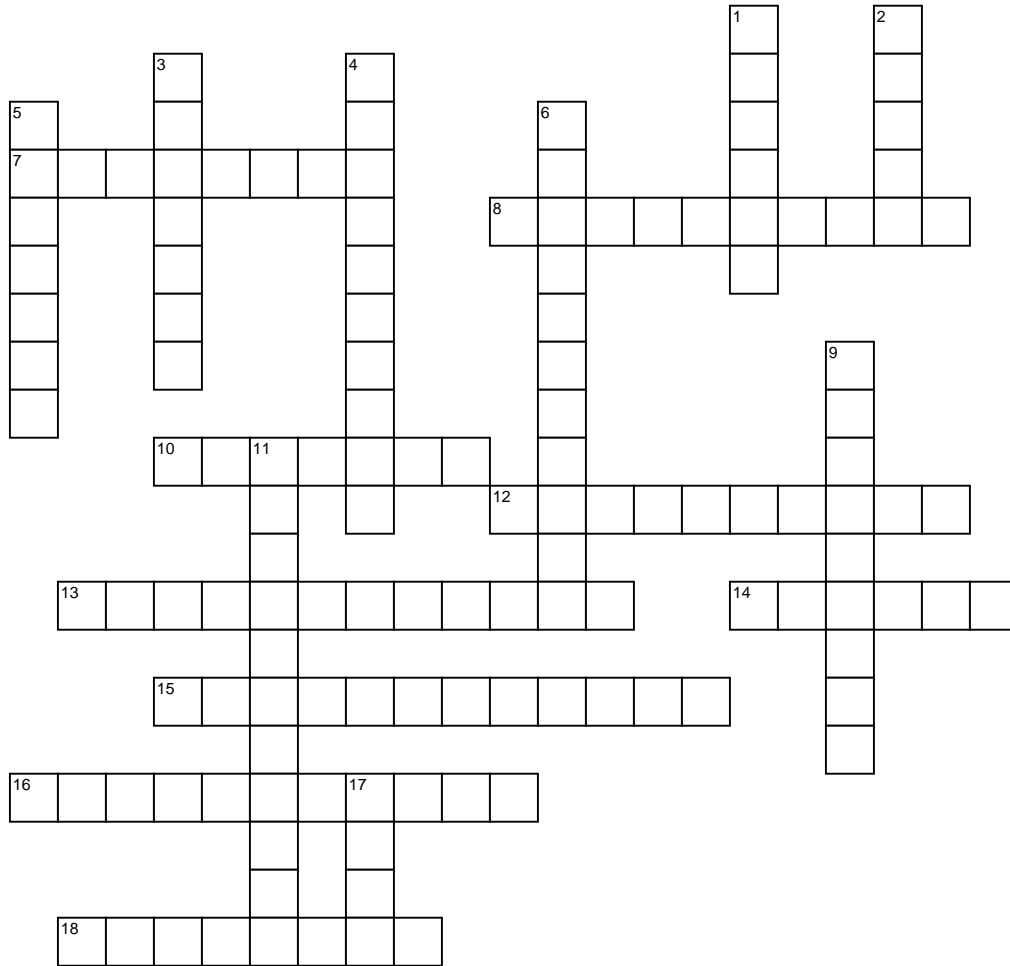


# Martin Luther King Jr. Crossword
